- 2. Silent Sound Garden Create a Sound Garden in your black scrapbook by pasting 3 colorful paper flowers, each showing a silent letter: , <w>, and <k>. On the five petals of each flower, write five words that have a silent letter & add a relevant picture for each word.
- 3. Pictionary Time: Choose 2 stories from the list: 'Frog & Toad Are Friends', 'The Cherry Tree' by Ruskin Bond, 'Grandma's Bag of Stories' by Sudha Murty, or any story of your choice.
