

His negotiations in the early 1990s with South African Pres. F.W. de Klerk helped end the country's apartheid system of racial segregation and ushered in a peaceful transition to majority rule. Prepare a biography based on his life, work and achievements. You can include the details about his style of writing their Biography.



BIOGRAPHY STRUCTURE

ORIENTATIONS (BEGINNING) open your biography with a <u>strong hook</u> to grab the reader's attention

SEQUENCING: In most cases, biographies are written in chronological order unless you are a very competent writer consciously trying to break from this trend.

COVER: childhood, upbringing, education, influences, accomplishments, relationships, etc. - everything that helps the reader to understand the person.

CONCLUSION: Wrap your biography up with some details about what the subject is doing now if they are still alive. If they have passed away, make mention of what impact they have made and what their legacy is or will be.







- 3. The project report should be spiral bounded.
- 4. The project report will be developed and presented in this order:
- Cover page showing project topic on top and student name, class, school name at the bottom. You can paste pictures supporting the project title.
- Acknowledgement (acknowledging the institution, libraries visits and persons who have helped).
- Index page: (make 3 columns) Serial No., List of contents and Teacher's signature.
- Project Overview: Purpose, Aim, Methodology and experiences while doing the project.
- Project content: with relevant topics and sub topics. Topics to be supported with suitable pictures.

- Bibliography: list of books, magazines, website with the specific website link used must be written.
- All the photographs and sketches should be pasted/done on the blank pages and labelled.
