- Data Collection and Analysis
 - Tables/graphs/charts may be included
- Findings and Conclusion, gestions/Recommendation, Bibliography

Important Instructions

- The project must be handwritten neatly.
- Use proper headings and presentation.
- Include original observations and responses.
- Avoid copying directly from the internet.
- Creative presentations will be appreciated.

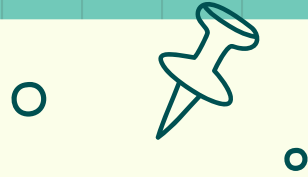
